For gallantry in the field and devotion to duty for the period 1.10.17 to 31.12.17. Especially on the night of 30/11/17 – 1/12/17. Sergt Major Aikman had control of the regimental ammunition Not only was he able to keep the ammunition up to the 9 th LH Regiment but was also able to dispatch 4000 rounds SAA to the 8 th ALH at a time when they required it badly.
